REASONS/EXPLANATION/NOTES:

- The original striping was an unbudgeted expense and the City Council, after listening to several business owner's appeals, voted to reverse the direction of vehicle traffic on Oak and Texas Streets around the square. These projects required re-striping of parking spaces, no parking areas, and crosswalks.
- 2) The original expense of \$4,700.00 plus the latest expense of \$7,366.80 were not budgeted items. To fund the original project, money was moved within the Streets Department funding lines.
- 3) Since the City has decided not to purchase the City Manager vehicle, which had a \$10,000.00 budget, moving these funds to the Streets Department will cover the cost of the re-striping and help, along with funds in other Streets Department funding lines, cover the cost of the original project.
