Hemphill Police Officers will perform police patrol, investigation, traffic regulation, crime prevention, and related enforcement activities.

The successful candidate will have knowledge of the following: criminal, civil, juvenile, traffic laws and regulations; City codes and ordinances; court systems and procedures; safety regulations applicable to motorized vehicles and equipment; radio communication; patrol vehicle camera operation; and routine vehicle and equipment maintenance.

The successful candidate will have skill and proficiency in the use of firearms, weapons, radio equipment, radar, the use of a police vehicle in emergency and non-emergency situations.

May take home vehicle if residence is in or near city limits.

Salary is negotiable dependent on qualifications/experience. The City provides employee health insurance for medical, prescription, dental, and vision, TMRS retirement/pension at 2:1 contribution 5%. The City provides holiday, sick, funeral, vacation, and birthday leave, and yearly incentive based on length of service and monthly salary.

Texas Licensed Peace Officer TCOLE Certified in good standing. Certification must be in order and up to date.

Must have High School Diploma or GED with documentation and valid Texas Driver's License.

Must have computer skills and knowledge of Microsoft Word.

Veterans must be honorably discharged and have copy of DD214.

Must not have any form of domestic violence charges in the past.

Must pass a background investigation, interview, pre-employment physical, psychological screening, and drug screen.
