## City of Hemphill Gas Safety Instructions

- 1. If you smell an odor you think is gas in your home, do **NOT** turn on lights, use your telephone, or ignite any flames. Get out of your home and call City Personnel immediately.
- 2. If you smell a gas odor outside your home do **NOT** expose an open flame to the leaking gas. Call City Personnel immediately.
- 3. If you decide to dig in your yard and do not know where your gas line is located, **CALL BEFORE YOU DIG!!** Call 811 with location information.
- 4. Make sure gas water heaters are properly vented, which means completely through the roof.
- 5. Be very careful when installing a gas water heater in a garage or other area where combustible liquids are stored. A stand of at least 18 inches high must hold your water heater off the floor in these type areas.
