## **Proof of Residency:**

Customer must produce a current utility bill as well as a photo I.D. to prove authorization to dispose of items.

Customers must certify that the waste was generated within the City Limits of Hemphill.

Anyone found to be disposing of waste not generated within the City shall have their privileges revoked.

## **General Rules:**

This facility is primarily for residential solid waste collection and disposal only. Commercial solid
waste (waste generated by businesses within the City limits) shall be accepted on a limited basis
and only with prior approval of City Hall. The City Manager shall make all determinations as to

- whether commercial waste shall be accepted and at what cost. Solid waste generated by contractors will not be accepted.
- 2. City Hall Personnel has the right to inspect and/or reject any load.
- 3. Facility users must unload where directed. Failure to unload where authorized will result in user privileges being revoked.
- 4. Facility users must be dressed in proper attire for safety reasons. (e.g. closed toe shoes only, gloves and long sleeves suggested).
- 5. Mixed loads shall not be accepted. (e.g. limbs and tree waste mixed with appliance or scrap metal)
- 6. Salvaging of materials may be authorized by City Manager.
- 7. Use of this facility shall be at the users own risk. Facility user shall indemnify and hold harmless the CITY and its agents and employees from all suits, actions, legal proceedings, damages, costs, expenses, attorney's fees or claims on account of any injury or damages received or sustained by any person or persons or property, arising out of, or occasioned by, the use of the waste disposal facility.
